International Travel Support Scheme

The Travel Grant Support Scheme (TGSS) Committee considered the applications of the following scientists seeking grants for attending National / International Conferences which starts between November 1st and November 30th 2019 in its meeting held on 08/9/2019. The recommendations of the committee are given below. Individual Communication is being sent to the approved candidates. No communication will be sent to the "not recommended" candidates. The Scheme provides to and fro economy class air fare by the shortest route, airport tax and visa fees or sometimes with a percentage of the expenditure shown depending upon the active research relationship with the WAIRCO. Young Scientist (below 35 years) will be provided registration fees also in addition to the above Support. The Candidates are advised to travel by the cheapest airbus by the shortest route. The sanctioned travel grant will be given at the conference venue by the program chair. It is required to attach a copy of the itinerary while claiming reimbursement at the Conference Venue. Without the itinerary, it will not be possible to reimburse the travel grant if the candidates travelled by other than cheapest Airlines submitted in the application.
